Please post this in the dining room for the men.

All drilling of all kinds, roughing, finishing and carving of features must be directed by the chief stone carver on the work and his directions followed.

The chief carver will be held responsible for the ways and the means for removing and finishing the sculpture.

No work must be put in hand for drilling or finishing not concurred in by the pointer chief and the sculptor.

The carver chief will select from the drillers the most experienced men for finishing.

I have appointed Luigi Bianco for this most important task. He will call upon the pointers to supply at call any points necessary to carry on the work and Arthur Johnson, foreman of the job on the mountain will give him immediate assistance in the supply of men, tools, scaffolding in advance of needs.
