## PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

Remember the Supreme Court of County of Westchester, at White Plains, N. Y.  
 the petition of LUIGI DEL BIANCO hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:  
 that My place of residence is 107 Purdy Avenue, Port Chester, NY  
 and My occupation is granite cutter  
 that I was born on the 9 day of May, anno Domini 1892, at Medano, Italy  
 that I emigrated to the United States from Naples, Italy on or about the 4 day of Sept.  
1920, and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York, on the 9 day of Oct.  
1920, on the vessel Dante Alighieri  
 that I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 21 day of June, anno Domini 1921  
Barre, Vt., in the U.S. District Court of Dist. of Vermont, Barre, Vt.  
 that I am married. My (wife's) name is Nicoletta, (she) was born on the 6 day of Dec., anno Domini 1902  
Port Chester, N.Y., and now resides at with me  
 that I have 2 children, and the name, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

that I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my wish to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and especially to Victor Emmanuel III, King of Italy of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to remain permanently in the United States.

that I am able to speak the English language.  
 that I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 1 day of October, anno Domini 1920, and in the State of New York continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 1 day of January, anno Domini 1925, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.
